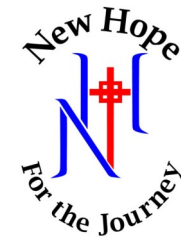

History of New Hope

New Hope Presbyterian Church is an outgrowth of the First Presbyterian Church of Barker, chartered November 19, 1906. A small wooden church on Barker-Clodine Road served the rural congregation, which was a part of the Gulf Coast Presbytery of the former United Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). The surrounding area and the church grew, and with no room to expand, the congregation decided to move and re-form the church. On November 19, 1978, New Hope Presbyterian Church was chartered with all the former Barker church members plus new members who were also excited about the new church venture. The Rev. William Schulenberg, who had been the last pastor at the Barker church, became New Hope's first pastor. A new building was completed in August of 1980 and included the current sanctuary, classrooms, and kitchen. Expanding programs needed more space, and in 1993 the addition including the fellowship hall, entrance-way and office area was dedicated.

New Hope is part of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), and belongs to the Presbytery of New Covenant and the Synod of the Sun which includes Texas, Oklahoma, Louisiana, and Arkansas.
